LVDL Board to Interview Potential Architects

Lake Villa District Library Board recently selected four architectural firms to interview for the library's building program project. Hiring the architect is the next step for the library on its continued path toward planning for growth.

"We've seen a dramatic shift in how people are using the library building" said Board President Tony Gundrum. "And to fully address that, we need a professional to help us move forward".

The Board reviewed submittals from 18 firms at a recent meeting and will interview the selected four firms Monday, June 23. Each architect will give a 30-minute presentation and will have an additional 30-minutes to field questions. The Board hopes to contract with an architect in July.
