Camosy Construction Awarded Library Project

The Lake Villa District Library Board has awarded the contract to build the new library to Camosy Construction.

Nine contractors submitted bids for the project and the three lowest bidders were thoroughly vetted by the library's construction team. As a governmental agency, the library is required to accept the lowest responsible bid and after checking references, Camosy was awarded the project. "We are confident that Camosy Construction is the right general contractor for the project," said library board president Tony Gundrum, "they bring years of construction experience and have worked with other community agencies."

Located in Zion, Illinois Camosy Construction has done many projects in the community including the Lindenhurst Park District, Lake Villa Fire Station Number 4 and Prince of Peace Parish.

The permit process continues and Camosy is selecting the sub-contractors for the project. Construction is expected to begin later this summer and will take approximately 16 months.
