TITLE: Displays and Exhibits Policy**DATE ADOPTED: March 16, 1987****REVISED: November 11, 2013**

Display space at Lake Villa District Library is available to the public as part of the Library's service to the community. The Library welcomes non-commercial displays and other materials of general interest to the community. Space for displays and exhibits is limited. In the use of display space, Library functions will take precedence over all others.

Displays may include educational, recreational, or cultural materials, or materials of general community interest. No materials will be accepted for displays that espouse a particular religion, cause, or political organization.

Due to demand, displays or exhibits not sponsored by Lake Villa District Library may be limited in location, scheduling, and/or duration.

People with items to display or exhibit in the Library are required to fill out the attached application form releasing the Library from responsibility for loss, theft, or damage to their materials.
