Lake Villa District Library to close at 6pm March 13, 2020.

March 13, 2020....In an effort to prevent the spread of COVID-19, Lake Villa District Library has made the decision to close effective at 6pm, Friday, March 13, 2020. The anticipated re-opening date is Monday, March 30, 2020.

This measure has been taken for the safety of the general public and library staff, not due to any known exposure.

During the closure, patrons are asked not to return library materials. All due dates have been extended and book returns will not be available.

Please note, the facility will still serve as an official polling site for precincts 149, 150 & 156 for the Primary Election on Tuesday, March 17, 2020. No library services will be provided that day.

Even though the building is closed, online resources are available. LVDL's digital catalog has books, audiobooks, music, comics, magazines, movies and TV shows for LVDL cardholders. The library's electronic resources are excellent tools for writing papers, learning a language, fixing a car and a whole lot more.
