Lake Villa District Library to celebrate Grand Opening Sunday, September 15

The new Lake Villa District Library will celebrate the grand opening of its new facility at 140 N. Munn Road, Lindenhurst, Illinois on Sunday, September 15. The Ribbon Cutting Ceremony will kick-off the event at 1pm followed by keynote speeches and the dedication of the new building.

Visitors are invited to tour and explore the facility. Library staff will be available to answer questions.

The 66,000 square foot facility, nestled on Crooked Lake, is comprised of three floors. The main level contains the adult collection, business center, public computers, study rooms, meeting rooms and space to enjoy light refreshments or to meet with friends. The lower level is the Youth Services Department and contains the youth collection, a dedicated computer area, hands-on activity and imaginative play areas, as well as plenty of places for parents and caregivers to watch over their children. The lower level also has a dedicated area for young adults--- students in grades 7 – 12-- that includes the YA collection, computers, study room, gaming room, program room and comfortable seating areas. Administration, other staff offices and board room are located on the upper floor.
