Lake Villa District Library Announces Service Update

In accordance with Phase III of the Restore Illinois Plan, Lake Villa District Library will implement services over the next two weeks. Beginning Monday, June 1, patrons can begin to return library materials. Curbside pickup will begin the following week, on Monday, June 8. Hours of operation for these services are Monday – Friday 10am – 1pm; Tuesday and Thursday 4-7pm.

The building will still be closed to the public as library administration works through the necessary steps to safely re-open. “It is out of an abundance of caution that we are taking a measured approach to reopening,” said Library Director Mikael Jacobsen. “There are many factors to consider and the top priority is the health and safety of patrons and staff.”

Since LVDL’s closure in March, patrons have taken advantage of the library’s digital collections and electronic resources, however, not being able to return physical materials (books, DVDs, etc.) has weighed heavily on their minds. “Returning materials is a small but important step in the process” said Jacobsen, “once we have a handle on the returns, we can move onto curbside pickup.”
