Plan Approved for New Lake Villa District Library

At the April 10 Lindenhurst Village Board meeting, the site and architecture plans for the new Lake Villa District Library were approved.

The new library will be located at 38110 N. Munn Road, approximately .75 miles from the current location. “This is an exciting time”, said Library Board President Tony Gundrum. “The Village Board approval was a pivotal step in the process; now we will begin the process of applying for permit.”

In addition to the library’s collection of books, DVDs and CDs, the 60,000 square foot building will offer state-of-the-art technology, an array of meeting rooms and collaborative spaces to accommodate a wide variety of needs, a dedicated area for tweens and teens, plenty of room for parents and caregivers to watch over their children and will be beautifully situated on Crooked Lake.

Construction will begin sometime this summer and will take approximately 15 months.
