## Library's Winter Reading Program Supports Northern Illinois Food Bank

Read to Serve, Lake Villa District Library's 2018 winter reading program, will benefit The Northern Illinois Food Bank, a non-profit organization that provides food to 800 community food pantries, soup kitchens and youth and senior feeding programs in 13 counties.

LVDL's winter reading program has long benefited a charity by calculating time spent reading or being read to. For every 15 minutes read, the Friends of LVDL donate .25 (up to \$5 per participant) directly to the food bank. Reading logs to track reading time will be available at any library service desk beginning Monday, January 15, 2018.

To complement this year's effort, the 2018 Winter One Book is Leanne Brown's *Good and Cheap*; a cookbook based on the SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) allowance of \$4 per day. Copies of the book, generously donated by the Friends of LVDL, will be available for checkout beginning Monday, January 15, 2018.
